


Key Statistics

- 2,130 ha planted
- Approx 300 groves
- 312,000+ trees
- Up to 400,000 litres produced per annum
- 40 olive mills
- Consumption approx 4.5m litres

Other Data

- Less than 30% of groves are irrigated
- Only four groves are certified as organic
- 40% use mechanical harvesters & 47% use branch shakers, balance by hand
- 12% produce table olives
- Continuing growth in flavoured oils

- Supermarket
 - National brands \$12 for 250ml, \$15 for 500ml
 - Regional brands \$16 for 250ml, \$28 for 500ml
- Farmers Markets/Grove Websites/Specialist Retailers
 - \$20 for 250ml, \$50+ for 1 litre is pretty typical.


- Represents 2/3 of growers

- Runs NZ EVOO Awards (2022 152 entries)
